

SITE UPDATE | January 2026

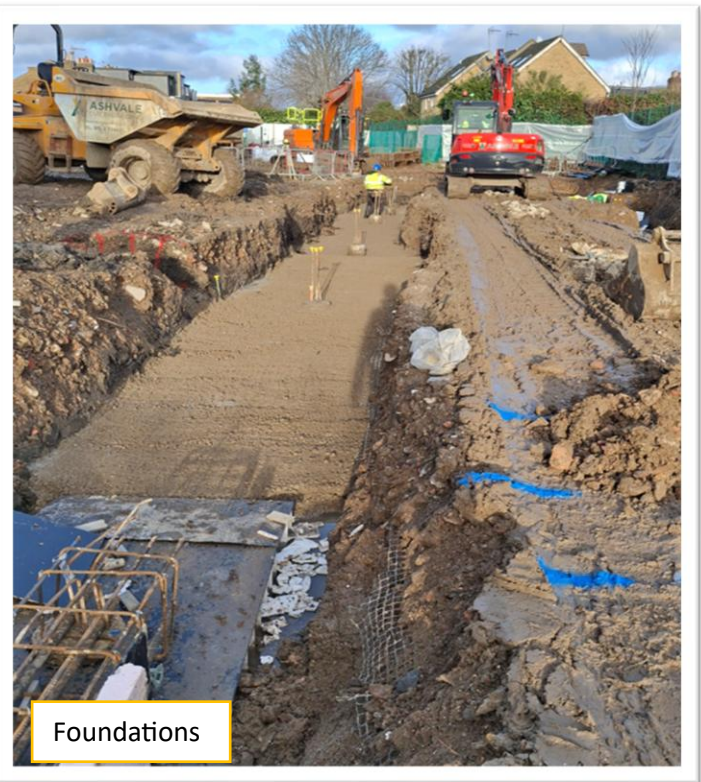
We are pleased to share the most recent update from the team at Bugler as we look to create new affordable and sustainable homes for local residents on behalf of Kingston Council.

Since our last newsletter, we have begun the reduced excavations for the ground beams. This stage includes cropping the piles, assembling the steel reinforcement cages, and installing shuttering within the excavations to prepare the reinforced ground beams for the upcoming concrete pour.

LOOKING AHEAD

In February, we will be continuing with the installation of the ground beams. Once the foundation concrete has been poured, sub-structure blockwork will commence on Block A.

We will also be installing the site crane, which will be supplied by London Tower Cranes, a well-established and experienced crane organisation. Crane installation is a highly technical process, and all activities will be carefully supervised by our appointed specialist to ensure the operation is carried out safely and efficiently.
