



SITE UPDATE | JULY 2026

We are pleased to provide an update on the progress of the Oval Project.

During this reporting period, significant progress was achieved across Parcels E (new Independent Living Scheme on former Hobbs Court site) and Parcel F (new community centre and Church next to the current building).

Parcel E

Good progress has been made on Parcel E over the past month. On Building E1, the ground floor and first floor concrete slabs have now been completed, and work on the second floor is around 80% finished. On Building E2, the ground support beams are complete and the blockwork below ground level is now over halfway finished, helping prepare the building for the next stage of construction.

Parcel F

Work has also started on Parcel F. A temporary site road has been installed to allow construction vehicles to access the area safely. Existing Openreach services have been moved out of the way, and work has commenced to divert the drainage system in preparation for future building works.

We are pleased to announce in this period we had our first Considerate Constructors Scheme audit. We scored a fantastic 88%.

As part of our social value commitments we are hoping to brighten up our hoarding by getting the community involved. The theme will be 'Stevenage is 80' in reference to the borough turning 80 this year. If you would like to get involved, please get in contact on the details below.



LOOKING AHEAD

Over the next few weeks, work will continue to move forward on Parcels E and F. On Building E1, the team will complete the second and third floors before starting work on the fourth floor. On Building E2, work will begin on the drainage system, followed by the installation of the ground floor structure and the start of the building's brickwork. On Parcel F, work will continue to divert the drainage system, helping prepare the area for future construction.
