



SITE UPDATE | JUNE 2026

We are pleased to provide an update on the progress of the Oval Project.

During this reporting period, significant progress was achieved across **Parcels E (new Independent Living Scheme on former Hobbs Court site) and Parcel F (new community centre and Church next to the current building)**.

At Parcel E, significant progress has been made on the building foundations and structure. Foundation piles have been prepared for the next stages of construction, drainage systems have been installed beneath the building footprint and work on the ground floor concrete slab is well underway. Construction of the building's columns, which will support the first floor has also progressed and a tower crane has been installed to assist with ongoing works across the site.

At Parcel F, foundation works have continued with the preparation of piles and the installation of ground beams, which help support the building structure. Concrete has been poured into these beams and work has now begun on the ground floor slab.

LOOKING AHEAD

Over the coming period, work at **Parcel E** will focus on continuing the installation of the ground floor concrete slab and progressing the columns up to first floor level. Construction of the first floor slab is also expected to begin, while foundation preparation and ground beam installation will continue in other areas of the parcel.

At **Parcel F**, preparations for future construction activities will include diverting existing utility services and drainage infrastructure where required. A temporary access road will also be installed to support site operations and maintain safe access throughout the construction programme.

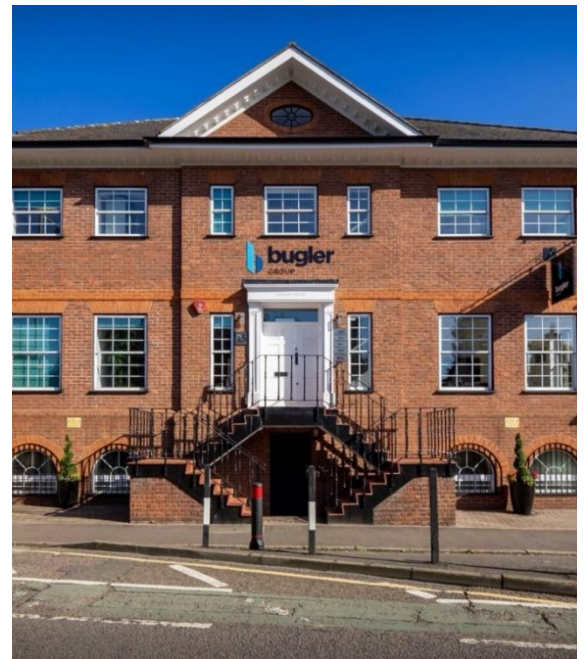
